

Ways to Search for Spare Rooms

Campus Notice Boards (enrolled students only)

Many current students use the notice boards placed around school to advertise a spare room in their house. Some students also place adverts looking for other housemates to join them in their search.

Student Website (enrolled students only)

The student website also provides a notice-board-style service where current students can advertise spare rooms or look for housemates.

Facebook

The Institute Facebook page is also a great place to post your own advert or look for other offers. We also have a specific House Hunting Forum (Group), which you can join to find other house-hunters and house offers.

SpareRoom (www.spareroom.co.uk)

Spare Room is arguably the UKs top Flat/Houseshare website. It is particularly useful if you end up as an individual looking for a room in a property that is already shared or have a room in your shared property to fill. You can register on the site and search by area, price, age and various other factors. You can also set up a profile for others to contact you and alerts for saved searches. You can browse for free, but there is a fee (for 7/14/28 days) to get contact details and respond to certain ads.

Gumtree

This is a very popular website for finding accommodation. Just be aware that it is a common place for scammers and fraudsters. Any landlord can list their property here and there are no rules on standards or regulations. It can however be very useful for finding spare rooms in houses already occupied. Always view the property first and never hand money over to anybody without seeing a contract from the landlord.

Letting Agents Introduction

When choosing to register with a letting/estate agent there may be some requirements. These procedures will vary between agents. Therefore ensure that you check what is required of you if you intend to secure accommodation through an agency.

Accommodation Agency fees

Letting agents can charge you for:

- ✓ Finding accommodation that you accept
- ✓ Drawing up tenancy agreements
- ✓ Credit checks

Letting agents cannot charge you for:

✓ Registering

Reserving Property

When you agree to take on a property you will be asked for a holding deposit. In most cases this deposit is non-refundable if you choose to withdraw your application for the property.

Down Payments

Before moving into a property you may be required to pay:

- First month's rent
- Dilapidation deposit
- Tenancy agreement fee
- Inventory fee

What is the dilapidation deposit used for? - Unpaid rent and/or bills, joint and several liabilities between tenants, leaving before the contract ends, damage to the property/inventory, accidental damage, cleaning and theft. Always confirm that the deposit will be treated in accordance with the Tenancy Deposit Protection regulations.

References

Before moving into the property the agency may require references from your employer, bank, current landlord, character reference and/or proof of ID. If you are unable to provide the above, they may ask for a UK guarantor.

Ways to Ensure the Return of Your Deposit

Acquire a written statement requesting:

- Name of the person holding the deposit
- Date deposit will be returned
- Why the landlord may be entitled to keep the deposit

Always ask for receipts for:

- Fees
- Rent
- Deposit

Inventory

Many landlords arrange for a professional inventory to be done. This document lists and describes the condition and contents of the property. You should meet with the inventory clerk preferably before you move in. This will allow you to go through the inventory in detail, and to make any comments. You should also obtain a copy of this inventory for your records.

At the end of your tenancy the inventory will be checked again and details of any dilapidations, breakages, cleaning etc will be noted. You should ask for a copy of this report. Any dilapidations, and possibly the report, will be deducted from the deposit.

Property Management

Whenever renting from an agent, it can be beneficial to ask if they also manage the property. This can reduce complications when issues arise with the property. When the property is not managed by the agent, it will be the responsibility of the landlord to deal with paying rent, building faults and issues. This can sometimes cause problems if the landlord is difficult to get hold of or does not maintain professional, high standards. We recommend whenever possible to rent a property managed by the estate agent.

Student Apartments

There are a range of student accommodation blocks available across London. They may mean travelling slightly further afield and will be more expensive, however they are often inclusive of all bills and include room-cleaning, laundry facilities, security systems and some even gym membership. They usually have shared kitchens and communal areas, so are are a great opportunity to meet other students and make friends.

Inglewood Mansions

This is a privately owned accommodation block situated in West Hampstead, a 20 minute walk from the Institute. It is not a dedicated student block, but provides a good option for all inclusive living. Council tax, bills and cleaning costs are included. They provide a 10% discount off admin fees for all Institute students.

Short-Term Accommodation

Should you still be seeking permanent accommodation when you arrive to start your course, your best option may be to stay in a hostel – this is often a particularly useful option for foreign students. These are some nearby options.

London Private Rooms

London Private Rooms are located in Willesden Green (one stop to Kilburn on the jubilee line) and provide both shared and private budget accommodation.

- Shared Accommodation Choose from 4, 6, 8 or 10 bed dorms (mixed or female only) starting at around £17 a night. All bedding is provided, a fully equipped shared kitchen, lounge room with plasma T.V, garden area, night caretaker, daily cleaners, no curfew, free internet and coin operated washer and dryer on site. Age restrictions of 18-45.
- Private Accommodation -Choose from single, double/twin, triple and quad rooms and studios starting at around £22 a night.

Palmers Lodge (Hillspring at Willesden Green)

Travelling to the Institute

The Institute has excellent transportation links. We have the Jubilee Underground Line from Kilburn (4 minute walk) and the London Overground from Brondesbury (2 minute walk away). There are also a number of buses that run locally along Kilburn High Road.

If you are concerned about journey time to the school every day, we recommend you find accommodation near a station on the London Overground Network or the Jubilee Underground line. This could include Camden Road, Kentish Town, West Hampstead, Willesden Junction, Shepherds Bush, Acton, Wembley, Swiss Cottage and St Johns Wood. There are of course hundreds of stations on these lines, but these are some of the closer options.

For travel purposes, London is divided into 6 zones. Zone 1 consists of Central London, and is the most expensive zone for travelling through. Our School is located in Zone 2. Please visit the Transport for London website for information on attaining a student travel pass, see www.tfl.gov.uk
